- 1. Group members write separated section of a text. They work independently and have little discussion during the process of writing (i.e., co-publishing).
- 2. Group members exchange ideas during the writing process, but create individual written products (i.e., co-responding, peer editing or peer feedback).
- 3. Group members write together and exchange ideas during the writing process, and they create one written product (i.e., co writing).

Teaching Writing in Indonesia

Writing in Indonesia has become an important thing to do in learning activities one of which is writing skills, there are several theories that explain the teaching of writing in Indonesia. According to (Ariyanti 2016, Anshori 2004, Ariyanti and fitriana 2017) as cited in M.
